The Neithercut Honors' Choir will perform live January 15 at the 2010 Charity Preview for North American International Auto Show (NAIAS) in Detroit. This is the choirs' first appearance at the NAIAS and the students are delighted to be a part of one of the largest auto shows in the world. In addition, the Charity Preview is a black-tie affair and considered one of the most exclusive, high-profile events in the nation.

The choir is scheduled to perform in the lobby of the Cobo Center between 5 p.m. and 6 p.m. during the invitation-only VIP Reception and Ribbon-Cutting Ceremony. Some of the songs to be sung at the event are: "In The Spirit;" "A Perfect Winter Day;" "The Heart of America;" "United We Sing;" and "Enjoy The Show."

Tickets for the Charity Preview are \$250 per person, of which \$240 is tax deductible. Proceeds directly benefit a wide range of children's charities. Funds raised will support services for children of all ages from birth to eighteen. Since 1989 the Charity Preview has raised more than \$79 million for southeastern Michigan children's charities – over \$35 million of which was raised in the last six years alone.
