On Friday, May 21, the choir will be going to Crossroads Village for the purpose of picture taking for the 2010 year book. Make sure your child is in school that day. Each student is responsible for bringing a sack lunch.

The NHC has been asked to participate in a very high profile media event on Saturday, May 22. The choir will sing two or three selections at the Mark Ingram (Heisman Trophy Winner) Celebration at Atwood Stadium. Parents are responsible for transportation to this event. Students will need to be there by 11:45am and will be finished by 12:45pm. If you are unable to stay, please make arrangements to have your child picked up by 12:45pm at Atwood Stadium. The Michigan Adventure trip has been rescheduled for Friday, May 28. The district no longer releases students for field trips after May 28. The bus will leave at 8:00am and return to Neithercut at 9:00pm. Choir members will need to be here no later than 7:30am that morning. Parents please make arrangements to pick up your child no later than 9:00pm. Chaperones for this trip have already been assigned.

In an effort to avoid issues from previous years, we are asking for your cooperation with our Michigan Adventure Trip 2010. District policy dictates the only passengers riding on the bus to the park are choir members and chaperones. Students will be assigned a chaperone to monitor their group for the entire day. This accountability is required to maintain a safe environment for our children. Even though we can't stop additional families members from traveling to the park on their own, we must ask that you not interrupt the group structure.
